

Dear Parents/Guardians,

DGF Elementary School is pleased to inform that starting <u>October 7th</u>, the **Violin Club** will be part of the school's after-school programs. In addition to learning how to play the violin, students will develop their creativity, language and reasoning, stimulate their memory and increase their body coordination. While working as a team, students will also learn how to express their ideas and emotions, develop and fine-tune auditory skills, and spatial intelligence. All while having fun and performing music with their peers.

The violin club will be available for 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students. Club will meet once a week from 2:35 p.m. to 3:20 p.m. in the music classroom. The school will offer two sessions:

have never played the violin, and are eager to
learn, are welcome in this session. No prior
violin knowledge or experience is required.

Spaces are limited and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. All instruments and materials for the club are provided by the school. If parents would like to purchase a personal instrument, <u>please contact the music teacher for guidance.</u>

Since this is an after school club, **parents are responsible for their child's transportation arrangements.** School buses will not be available to collect after-school club students. Punctuality is of utmost importance when picking up your child, tardiness will affect your child's club membership.


